Every step in each sector assurance chain must be a current member of the required third-party accreditation scheme/s

Abattoir	Pigs slaughtered and split into carcasses; meat not packed for sale	No Yes: if selling offal with a RT claim	RT Assurance for Meat & Poultry Processing Scheme (with scope for slaughter) or BMPA Pork Scheme Module 1 or QMS Processing Scheme
Abattoir & Cutting Plant	Pigs slaughtered, cut and packed	Yes	RT Assurance for Meat & Poultry Processing Scheme (with scope for slaughter and cutting of pork; must have RTMPP for slaughter but can have BRCGS Food Safety

Cutting Plant only	Brings in pig carcasses/primals to further prepare/cut/pack for sale to retailers/food service	Yes	RT Meat & Poultry Processing Scheme or BMPA Pork Scheme Module 2 or BRCGS Food Safety Standard or QMS Processing Scheme or FSSC 22000 or IFS Food
Catering Butcher	Brings in pork primals to further prepare/cut/pack for sale to food service	Yes	RT Meat & Poultry Processing Scheme or BMPA Pork Scheme Module 2 or BRCGS Food Safety Standard or FSSC 22000 or IFS Food
Further Processing - uncooked	Brings in approved product to further process <i>i.e.</i> mince, cut, dice	Yes	RT Meat & Poultry Processing Scheme or BMPA Pork Scheme Module 2

Sausage & Bacon (Pigs in Blankets)	Producing composite products. Incoming product must be from a RT Licensed site.	Yes	<p>In the case of composite products e.g. pigs in blankets, each product component i.e. the bacon and the sausage, shall be certified against the appropriate BMPA Pork Scheme module. The site at which the composite product is being produced shall have current certification against one of the BMPA Pork Modules (2, 3, 4 or 5). More information can be found here</p>

Wholesaler	Takes delivery from RT Licensed site/s and/or distributes the product. Product arrives and leaves in the same state (no splitting of packs or repacking)	Yes	<p>N/A</p> <p>All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor Licensed company</p>
Trader	Products sourced from licensed packers. Does not take physical ownership/handle the product/s, arranges distribution and storage	Yes	<p>N/A</p> <p>All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor Licensed company</p>



Food Service	Purchases and promotes RT pork and/or pork product/s using the RT Logo or Claim on menus, websites, magazines etc.	Yes	N/A All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor Claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor Licensed company. The RT Claim must be specific to the Red Tractor product being promoted and not misleading to the consumer in any way
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
